The wine is a whole-cluster co-fermentation of DeChaunac, Marechal Foch, Marquette, Prairie Star, and Louise Swenson for 20 days before being pressed into old oak barrel. an intense expression of vibrant fruit, interwoven with grey clay and autumnal aromatics. Summer flowers dried on an old leather saddle, Spontaneous/wild fermentation, spontaneous malolactic fermentation. No sulfites added.</i>	

ROSÉ WINES

By Glass/Bottle

- 401 Rosé: Cabernet Sauvignon (2021)(92 pts. WE). Steininger Wines. Austria 14/49
Lemon and hints of strawberry compote are appetizing on the nose. The palate comes in with zingy freshness that lifts and brightens the entire wine. The lemon finish is bone dry and vivid.
- 402 Rosé (Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre) – Love You Bunches. (2021)(91 pts. WE). Stolpman. Los Olivos - California 14/48
Precise and popping with bright energy. A scrumptious rosé. Strawberry married with cool, firm peach. Breezy lemon-lime and lifting mint combine effortlessly through the light and playful palate. Smooth, with just a hint of refreshing tang on the finish
- 403 Rosé: Pinot Noir – Gaia “Earth Goddess” (2022). Domaine Bousquet. Argentina 14/49
Pale and pretty pink. Strawberry and red berry aroma with orange zest and floral notes. Lively acidity with creamy mid-palate.
- 404 Rosé: Txakolina (2022)(90 pts. Vinous). Senorio de Astobiza. Txakoli (Basque Region) - Spain 15/52
Hondarrabi Beltza (black) and Hondarrabi Zuri (white) grapes. A lovely floral nose of strawberries and white flowers is followed by a clean and dry palate offering fresh acidity. Balanced minerality from the soil, long aromatic finish.

SKIN-CONTACT or “ORANGE” WINES

- 405 La Crescent (unfiltered) - Tectonic. Iapetus. Vermont 79
The aroma is complex and layered, with notes of apricot, peach, raisin, white pepper, tea, rose water, and floral attributes; you could keep your nose in this all-day. This vintage is light-bodied and has delicacy and balance. On the palate, Tectonic's tannin and acidity are integrated, with a tartness and texture reminiscent of tea and thick-skinned tropical fruits.
- 406 Pinot Blanc Cuvée (40% Chardonnay, 10% Pinot Gris) – Leptir (2019). Sanctum Wines. Slovenia 13/42
This youthful orange wine opens with spicy aromas of dry wildflowers, apricots, pears and white tea with honey. The palate is bright, and the skin tannins are not aggressive. Earthy mid-palate leads to a long savory finish.

SLIGHTLY CHILLED RED WINES

- 407 Nerello Mascalese – Susucaru (2017)(94 pts. WE). Frank Cornelissen. Etna – Sicily 129
85% Nerello Mascalese with the remainder split between Nerello Capuccio, Alicante Boushet, Minella and Uva Francesca. The juice is fermented with indigenous yeasts and remains in contact with the skins for 60 days. The aging takes place in neutral tanks made of epoxy. Full of personality – vibrant aromas of brambly berries, herbs, and ash, with crunchy flavors of pomegranate and cranberry. Smokey minerality lingers. Cleansing acidity and fine tannins guide across the palate,
- 408 Syrah Cuvée – Crunchy Rôastie (2022)(91 pts. WE). Stolpman. Los Olivos - CA 21/73
This blend of Syrah (95%) and Viognier (5%) offers super fresh aromas of strawberry, carnation, rose and flaky pastry for a very approachable nose. There's a firm, if quick, tannic edge to the palate of strawberry paste, pomegranate, and white-pepper.

SAKE FLIGHT

- 409 HeavenSake Trio – “Katsuyama Junmai Ginjo Azur; “Urakasumi” Junmai Daiginjo; “Konishi”
Junmai 12. - \$49 for flight of 3 (3.5 oz pours); \$24 for 5 oz. pour of one selection
Masterfully composed by acclaimed French cellar master Régis Camus, made in collaboration with Japan's most respected sake brewers. The smoothest sake possible. The highest standards of balance, purity and refinement.

WHITE WINES

- 501 Blanc de Blancs – “La Cuvée d’Astéria” (2022). Chateau Kefraya. Bekaa Valley – Lebanon 66
Named for the Greek Goddess Astéria, this a typical blend of Viognier, Chardonnay, Muscat Blanc à Petits Brains and Sauvignon Blanc expresses floral notes of lily and acacia, mingled with flavors of honey, apricot and mango. Extremely fresh.
- 502 Blanc de Noir – “Blindfold” The Prisoner (2021) (92 pts WE). The Prisoner Wine Co. Sonoma 24/82
Still, white-pressed pinot noir with notes of fresh, in-season citrus, white flower, white peach, a hint of tart cranberry. Delicate but lively, elegant, zesty & bright. This wine is made from mostly pinot noir with small amounts of Viognier and Gewürztraminer.
- 503 Bordeaux (89 pts WE) - Lune Blanche. Clos de Lunes. Pessac-Léognan - France 16/54
A blend of 70% Sémillon, 30% Sauvignon Blanc. Bright acidity and vibrant fruitiness. Delicious and a pleasant floral character.
- 504 Burgundy – Saint-Veran – En Messie. Daniel Pollier. France 17/57
100% Chardonnay. The nose is very subtle with dried fruit and hazelnut predominating. The palate is very pleasant with freshness and balance.
- 505 Chardonnay (2022)(90 pts WE). Netzl. Austria 19/69
Unoaked. Organic. In the fragrance, a combination of exotic fruit and spice, juicy pear, fresh limes, on the palate the juicy fruit is pushed into the foreground by a pleasant acid structure, creamy and long-lasting on the finish – a classic
- 506 Chardonnay - Pacificana (2022)(90 pts WE). Winc Wines. Acampo (Central Coast) – CA 13/44
This bold and engaging Chardonnay showcases classic California styles for the next generation of wine enthusiasts. It isn’t the oak bomb style of ten years ago; instead, it strikes the perfect balance between richness and elegance.
- 507 Chardonnay Cuvée - The Prisoner “Carneros” (2019). The Prisoner Wine Co. Oakville - CA 109
This blend of Chardonnay, Roussanne and Gewürztraminer presents a pale color with aromas of stone and citrus fruits with toast oak. On the palate, flavors of crisp apple and peach with citrus zest and nutty vanilla notes. Well balanced with acidity. Medium finish with fruit, oak, and mineral character.
- 508 Chardonnay – Santa Rita Hills (2020)(92 pts. WE). Sea Smoke. Central Coast - CA 174
A concentrated white peach element plays strongly on the nose of this coveted bottling, with touches of sea salt and a sharp tangerine-like edge. Ripe peach and cherimoya flavors show on the palate, but a crescendoing citrus-driven acidity cuts through the richness and allows more savory components like salt and smoked nut to blossom on the finish.
- 509 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc (2019)(92 pts. WE). La Nerthe. Rhône Valley 76
Hints of toast and spice accent fresh yellow apple in a densely structured blend of Grenache Blanc, Roussanne, Clairette and Bourboulenc. Rich and voluminous on the palate, brightened by lemon notes and minerality.
- 510 Chenin Blanc (2021)(88 pts WE). Kumusha. Breedekloof – South Africa 12/42
Fresh, fruity and inviting, with enticing aromas of juicy Bartlett pear, Honeycrisp apple and mandarin that fill the nose. Light weight and clean on the sip, with a bright citrus edge that continues to a refreshing finish.
- 511 Clairette Blanche (54%), Grenache Blanc (46%) – Beautiful Earth (2019)(94 pts WE). McPrice Myers. Paso Robles 22/76
A balanced, refreshing and exciting blend begins with fresh and even minty aromas of honeysuckle, kiwi and crushed seashell on the tight nose. A chalky grip grabs hold of the palate with engaging ripe melon and mint.
- 512 Gewürztraminer (2020)(91 pts WE). Ravines Cellars. Geneva (Finger Lakes) - NY 18/62
Rich layers of rose petal, apricot, lychee and spiced pear intermingle with white pepper and sweet spices. Driving acidity is balanced by an elegant, fresh and enduring finish. Lovely aromatics.

513	Grüner Veltliner (2022)(91 pts WE). Paul Direder. Austria	14 glass only
	<i>A lovely blend of with a fragrant lift of honeysuckle and grape rises from the glass. The palate is light and dry—still floral yet tinged with lemony freshness. Easy and bright like a summer breeze</i>	
514	Pinot Blanc (2023). Girasole. Mendocino, California	14/50
	<i>Beautiful pale lemon yellow, with aromas of lychee fruit, white peach, mandarin orange and zesty lemon marmalade. Its entry is crisp and lively, followed by an ample, medium-bodied mid-palate. It finishes with an invigoratingly lively crispness that's at once quenching, while still leaving you wanting more!</i>	
515	Pinot Grigio (2022). Famiglia Castellani. Tuscany - Italy	12/44
	<i>Balanced bouquet with notes of apple, peach and white flowers. Fresh and harmonious on the palate. Great with fish or vegetables.</i>	
516	Pinot Gris - O.P.P. - Other People's Pinot Gris (2023). Maison Noir. Oregon	16/59
	<i>Dry, lively and refreshing with flavors of crisp pear, green apple, and a hint of citrus. Bright acidity and a smooth, clean finish.</i>	
517	Riesling (2021)(90 pts. WE). Ravines Cellars. Geneva (Finger Lakes) - NY	15/52
	<i>Sustainable. A truly bone-dry Riesling that is uncharacteristically austere. A lean, light body and a mineral laden, wet-stone palate. Lots of freshly squeezed lime and a citrus rind finish makes this an elegant, drinkable choice.</i>	
518	Roussanne, Grenache Blanc, Marsanne & Viognier – “Coquille Blanc” (91 pts WE)(2022)	18/69
	<i>Subtle aromas of peach, yellow flower, buttered toast and sea salt show on the nose of this splendid blend. A salty streak shoots through the ripe peach, apricot and buttered brioche flavors of the rich palate.</i>	
519	Sauvignon Blanc (2021)(90 pts WE). Kumusha Wines. Sondagskloof, South Africa	13/46
	<i>Fresh-cut grass, melon rind, green mango and lime peel lead the nose of this bright and attractive white wine. It's light and zippy on the palate, with a vibrant acidic cut and more green-fruited flavors that carry through to a mouth-watering finish.</i>	
520	Txakoli de Alava (2020)(90 pts. Vinous). Senorio de Astobiza. Txakoli (Basque Region) - Spain	15/52
	<i>95% Hondarrabi Zuri and 5% Hondarrabi Zuri Zuratie.. Delicious and brightly fresh, ripe fruit. Aromas of white pear, young peach, green apple, and fresh grapefruit lead to an extremely fresh palate that is balanced with minerality, acidity, and persistence.</i>	
521	Verdejo (organic)(2019)(88 pts WE). Cuatro Rayas. Rueda - Spain	14/49
	<i>A slightly yeasty aroma melds with apple and citrus on the nose. The plump palate is balanced by zesty acidity, while flavors of melon, apple and pineapple are in charge.</i>	
522	Vermentino & Colombana Cuvée – Fonte delle Donne (2022)(91 pts WE). Fibbiano. Tuscany	15/51
	<i>Lovely, tangy. Aromas of yellow stone fruit, citrus, and Mediterranean herbs. Savory palate. Fresh acidity accompanies ripe apricot, grapefruit and almond before an orange drop candy close.</i>	
523	Vinho Verde (Loureiro, Arinto, Trajadura) – Bico do (2023). Quinta das Arcas. Portugal	13/44
	<i>Bright, lemony color. Fruity and fresh aroma with evident green apple. The flavor has soft minerality and good balance.</i>	
524	Viognier – Wyldvin Vineyard (2023). Meadowcroft. Dry Creek Valley - CA	17/59
	<i>Crafted in the traditional Northern Rhône style, with a new world edge, this supple and balanced wine was aged in French-oak after being stainless-steel fermented. This lively white opens in a flourish of dried apricot, honey and passionfruit. On the palate crisp clean acidity is mingled with flavors of baked apple and notes of bergamot.</i>	

RED WINES

- 601 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico (2012)(93 pts WE). Nicolis. Veneto - Italy 129
Corvina 65% – Rondinella 20% – Molinara 5% Croatina 10%. Deep dark ruby red which turns into garnet. Powerful and aristocratic nose made of ripe fruit, jam, sensations of cocoa, walnut, tobacco, and leather. Elegant and powerful wine with a spicy bouquet of distinct flavors; an impressive balance between volume and smoothness, warmth and crispness, austerity, and richness.
- 602 Barbaresco (2013)(90 pts WE). Luigi Voghera. Piedmont - Italy 99
This leads with menthol, new leather, exotic spice and balsamic notes. The concentrated palate offers dried black cherry, tobacco and star anise flavors set against firm, fine-grained tannins and bright acidity.
- 603 Barolo (2013)(DOCG)(91 pts. WE). Réva. Monforte D'Alba. Italy 129
Rose petal, red-skinned berry and leather aromas take center stage. The juicy palate offers Morello cherry, clove and white pepper alongside taut fine-grained tannins.
- 604 Blaufränkisch – (2019)(93 pts WE). Hillinger. Burgenland, Austria 17/59
Intense black, purple color with a very short rim, the nose is very complex with lots of blackberries, bilberries, cherry, and dried fruit. On top, the perfectly integrated roasted aromas are supported by the typical spice. Very long finish, grippy tannins.
- 605 Bordeaux Red - "Trintaudon" Cru Borgeois (91 pts WE). Chateau Larose. Haut- Médoc 20/74
An elegant, fruity blend of 58% Merlot and 42% Cabernet. The wine comes from vines on the edge of the Pauillac appellation, with deep gravel soil that gives structure to the approachable black fruits. Wine Enthusiast "Editor's Choice".
- 606 Brunello di Montalcino (2018)(91 pts WS). Albatreti. Tuscany -Italy 179
Aromas of forest floor, oak-driven spice, crushed aromatic herb and blue flower slowly appear in the glass. On the rounded, full-bodied palate, taut, fine-grained tannins and fresh acidity accompany juicy black cherry, coffee bean and licorice.
- 607 Burgundy – Old Vine Pinot Noir (2020)(92 pts WE). Albert Bichot. Beaune - France 17/60
Old vines. Flattering nose with an appealing palette of fruity aromas (black currant, red currant, plum). Fleshy and balanced.
- 608 Cabernet Franc (2022). Ravines. Finger Lakes – New York 18/65
A gentle spiced cranberry 100% estate, sustainably grown wine. Incredibly fresh and inviting with aromas of redcurrant, cranberries and mountain herbs. The palate is pure and elegant, with notes of raspberries and hints of earth and spice. A perfect rendition of Finger Lakes Cabernet Franc, aged for a year in 6-year-old, 2000 liter Austrian and Hungarian Oak casks.
- 609 Cabernet Sauvignon – In Sheep's Clothing (2020). Maison Noir. Washington 17/59
Delivers a ripeness of fruit flavors while preserving the acidity that gives the medium to full-bodied wine a sense of freshness. With layers of cassis, blueberries, and black cherries, this wine lends to a New World style of fruit with more of an Old World structure with a hint of wood smoke. This wine fully embraces an integral part of classic Cabernet Sauvignon by highlighting a complex blend of dried herbs: anise, thyme and bay leaf.
- 610 Cabernet Sauvignon – Gigglespot (2021)(90 pts WS). Mollydooker. Australia 106
Elegant balance; layers of sweet fruit rolling over dark chocolate; rich, creamy palate with grand finish.
- 611 Cabernet Sauvignon – Double Back (2019)(96 pts Wine Adv). Bledsoe. Columbia Valley – WA 344
Drew Bledsoe's retirement plan, after 14 years as an NFL quarterback, Doubleback brought him back to his hometown of Walla Walla to make wine. Crushed rock aromas open on a savory note, joining complex veins of dark fruit wrapped in tobacco leaf and mint. Vibrant energy and impressive structure; lovely berry fruit balanced with crushed herbs.
- 612 Cabernet Sauvignon - Estate (2020)(92 pts WE). Ghost Block. Oakville – California 189
Organic. 5% Malbec and 5% Petit Verdot. Opens on a perfumed nose of sage, lavender and rose petal. Persistent tones of clove and baking spice complement the brooding blackberry and sanguine notes. Medium bodied with an elegant finish.

- 613 Cabernet Sauvignon (Cabernet Franc and Merlot) – *Mercury Head* (2018). Orin Swift. Napa 294
Aromatics of plum and cherry, dark chocolate, leather and Rutherford Dust coalesce from the glass. The entry is elegant and floods the palate with notes of cassis, blackberry, blueberry, caramel and a touch of cinnamon and brown sugar. Dusty tannins.
- 614 Cabernet Sauvignon – *Palermo* (2019)(90 pts RP). Orin Swift. Napa 162
Delicious aromas of raspberry and cherry intermingle with notes of star anise, five spice and freshly steeped black tea. The palate is softly textured and smooth with a combination of cassis and blackberry notes. Lengthy finish.
- 615 Cabernet Sauvignon Cuvée – *Papillon* (2018)(90 pts RP). Orin Swift. Napa 212
It's rare to find a Napa Valley wine composed of all five Bordeaux-style varietals! The raw strength and prestige of Cabernet Sauvignon buttressed by the opulence of Merlot, the spiciness of Cabernet Franc, the depth of Malbec and the sheet unctuousness of Petit Verdot come together seamlessly.
- 616 Cabernet Sauvignon & Cinsault Cuvée (2021). Kumusha Wines. Slanghoek – South Africa 15/52
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (75%) and Cinsault (25%). Ripe cherry and plum flavors, with hints of pomegranate and strawberry. Complements all types of juicy red meat dishes, especially slow-cooked ones.
- 617 Carignane Cuvée - *Coquille Rouge* (2018)(93 pts. WE). Carol Shelton. Sonoma – CA 16/59
Rhône Valley inspired. Stunning blend of Carignane and Grenache Noir bring tangy red fruit, Mourvedre fills in with savory gaminess, Alicante Boushet adds spicy blueberry fruit (and color!), and Petite Sirah gives peppery backbone.
- 618 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge – *Secret Barville* (2016)(95 pts. WE). Brotte. Rhône Valley 132
Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre create a rich, undulating blend with firm tannins. Studded with glossy blueberry and black-cherry flavors, its and intense, brooding wine shaded by hints of crushed earth and coffee grinds.
- 619 Chianti Classico Riserva (2017)(DOCG). Famiglia Castellani. Pontedera (Tuscany) – Italy 14/49
Deep ruby red. Rich with notes of cherries, plums, and iris. Deep cherry and leather flavors with subtle wood notes. Supple tannins, good acidity, and a lingering finish. Perfect with flavorful roasts, pastas, and cheeses.
- 620 Côtes-du-Rhône – *Espirit* (2022). Brotte. Rhône Valley - France 12/42
This Grenache-Syrah blend will impress with its wild red fruits and spices, plus that authentic dried brush (garrigue) and lavender which is so distinctive to this region. Easy drinking, food-friendly, crowd-pleasing.
- 621 Douro – *Dezoito by Maniche* (2019). Quinta da Pacheca. Dão - Portugal 20/74
A blend of Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca and Tinta Roriz. Very fruity in the aroma, with evident blackberry and plum aromas, balanced with chocolate notes provided by the barrels, shows balance in the mouth, with solid tannins and a long finish.
- 622 Grenache (Cannonau) – Reserve (2022)(90 pts WE). Sella & Mosca. Sardinia 14/48
Full-bodied. Mesmerizing scent, redolent of violets. Warm, dry and harmonious palate with plummy fruit.
- 623 Grenache Cuvée (Syrah, Mourvedre) – *Cherries & Rainbows* (2022). Languedoc - France 14/49
Sulfite-free. Organic. Plum, dark cherry, boysenberry, blackberry, violet, sage, forest floor, menthol, eucalyptus and black licorice.
- 624 Grenache Cuvée (Syrah, Petite Sirah) – *Abstract* (2016)(92 pts WS). Orin Swift. Napa 25/89
Aromatic notes of Luxardo cherries, ripe black plums and raspberries billow, with intricate hints of coffee, mocha and caramel. The entry is expansive with dark briar fruits, cola and cocoa with soft tannins. Finishes with a sweet oak presence.
- 625 Kotsifali (10%Mavrotagano)(dry) – *Klima* (2022). Karavitakis Winery. Crete – Greece 19/70
Old vine blend. Kotsifali bring very fruity and intense character; the Mavrotagano contributes its elegant but robust character. Dark cherry and plum aromas, nuances of sage, lingering acidity and subtle red spice. Well-structured with flavor depth

- 626 Malbec – *Reserve*. (91 pts JS). Domaine Bousquet. Tupungato Uco Valley – Argentina 14/49
Organic. High elevation. Rich aroma, lively acidity, plummy and briary fruit flavors. A dash of French elegance from the family's origins and just a touch of oak. 2023 IWSC trophy for "Best Red Wine Producer".
- 627 Merlot – *The Scooter* (2019)(90 pts WS). Mollydooker. Australia 19/72
An aromatic lift of plum, spice and chocolate with a seamless structure; 65-75% fruit weight.
- 628 Nebbiolo D'Alba – *Uva e Mane 'Fortunato'* (2016)(91 pts. WE). Buganza Wines. Italy 17/68
Gorgeous aromas of purple flowers, mushroom, and the sweet tones of brambly underbrush. In the mouth, it is fresh and full of red and black fruit, floral tones, and the grip of distant tannins right in line with the acidity that lasts through to the finish.
- 629 Petite Sirah, Zinfandel, Syrah, Malbec Grenache. (2022)(92 pts. WE).
"Locations" by Dave Phinney. Napa, CA 17/63
Aromas of blueberry compote, maraschino cherries, brambly raspberry and a touch of licorice and tomato leaf. The silky palate Bursts with flavors of ripe strawberry, red plum, kirsch and graham cracker. Chalky tannins and a long-structured finish.
- 630 Petite Sirah, Syrah, Grenache – *Machete* (2016)(92 pts. WS). Orin Swift. Napa, CA 139
A nose of black plums, cassis, and cacao engage. A progressing palate of blackberry and boysenberry compote, a reduction of dark plum and ripe figs and pure Amarena cherry. Flashes of vanilla and traces of minerality evolve into chalky tannins on the finish.
- 631 Pinot Noir – *Two Estates* (2022)(92 pts. WE). Anne Amie. Willamette Valley - Oregon 24/85
Pale to medium ruby-purple color, this wine springs from the glass with notes of raspberry tart, cranberry sauce and rhubarb pie plus hints of Provence herbs and forest floor. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is softly spoken with a nice chewiness.
- 632 Pinot Noir – *Slander* (2019)(91 pts. Wine Advocate). Orin Swift. Napa 112
Pale to medium ruby-purple color, this wine springs from the glass with notes of raspberry tart, cranberry sauce and rhubarb pie plus hints of Provence herbs and forest floor. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is softly spoken with a nice chewiness.
- 633 Pinot Noir – *Ten* (2020)(94 pts. WE). Sea Smoke. Central Coast - California 195
Biodynamic. A brooding and intense wine. The aromas begin with notes of Elderberry, Freesia and Fig, then a myriad of savory spices, and a hint of lavender. Firm, mature tannins are followed by a long, velvety finish.
- 634 Rioja (Tempranillo - Toro) – *El Picaro* (2022)(92 pts. WE). Matsu. Spain 14/49
A young wine with fresh aromatics and full flavor. Displays good aroma intensity of blackberries and blueberries, combined with mineral notes. Fresh entry on the palate, with rich flavors, complexity and good fruit extract. Smooth and pleasant.
- 635 Sangiovese (2020)(87 pts. WE). Noelia Ricci. Romagna - Italy 65
Aromas of red berry and underbrush. Cheerful palate of strawberry, cinnamon and a hint of orange peel alongside smooth tannins.
- 636 Shiraz - *Blue-Eyed Boy* (2015)(92 pts WS). Mollydooker. Australia 114
Smooth, rich, and satiny; incredibly aromatic with alluring notes of blackberry, cherry, licorice, and vanilla bean.
- 637 Shiraz - *Carnival of Love* (2016)(93 pts WS). Mollydooker. Australia 215
At 85-95% fruit weight, it has elegance; an intense and seamless flavor spectrum; sumptuous mouth-feel and perfect balance. Voted "Top Wine in the World" three years in a row by Wine Enthusiast.
- 638 Syrah Cuvée – *Les Bretèches* (2020). Château Kefraya. Bekaa Valley - Lebanon 22/79
This blend with Cinsaut, Cabernet Sauvignon and Tempranillo, is a quintessential Lebanese wine. With a finely spiced nose of blackcurrant and cherry, it reveals silky tannins and generous red fruit flavors.

- 639 Syrah Cuvée – *Para Maria* (2021)(91 pts. WE). Stolpman. Los Olivos - CA 17/54
This blend of Syrah (80%), Petite Verdot (20%) delivers a core of red and black fruit with notes of black pepper, anise, and hints of red cherry. A dark and brooding wine.
- 640 Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore (2020)(88 pts WE). Taveggia. Verona – Italy 20/72
Cherries, dried fruit and hints of black spice, dried cardamon and viola. Fresh with tight nit, polished tannins
- 641 Zinfandel Cuvée - *The Prisoner* (2019)(92 pts WE). The Prisoner Wine Co. Napa Valley 27/99
Inspired by the wines first made by the first Italian immigrants in Napa Valley, The Prisoner has led the resurgence of interesting blends by incorporating Zinfandel with the unlikely mix of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, Syrah, and Charbono. Bright aromas of raspberry, vanilla, and coconut give way to flavors of blackberry, pomegranate, and vanilla; lingering and luscious finish.
- 642 Zinfandel Cuvée (Syrah, Petite Sirah) - *Eight Years in the Desert* (2020)(91 pts RP). 135
 Orin Swift. Napa, CA
Deep maroon. Aromas of wild blackberry, pepper, raisin cookie, Sequoia forest, bay leaf, and spices. The entry is broad and opulent with a mid-palate of brambly raspberry, black cherry, blueberry, and a hint of cacao. Ripe tannins and sweet oak on the long finish.
- 643 Zweigelt (cuvée) – *Ried Bärnreiser Anna Christina* (2016)(94 pts WE). Netzl. Austria 169
Very elegant. Organic. Zweigelt blended with Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Dark plum, chocolate and graphite on the nose still need to unfurl fully. The dense palate is tightly wound and bound in its firm but fine structure of drying, taut tannins.
