**Americano** – Campari, Turmeón sweet vermouth, lemon, soda water, tall glass on the rocks

**Aperol Spritzer** – Prosecco, Aperol, orange, on the rocks

**Getariako Txakolina (2019)**(90 pts Vinous). Bodegas Aizpurua. Basque Region – Spain

*A crisp, dry white wine from the Basque Country (DO Gipuzkoa) made primarily from Hondarrabi Zuri grapes.*

*Characterized by high acidity, low alcohol, and a slight spritz. It features citrus, green apple, and briny, mineral notes. Terrific with oysters!*

**Hugo Spritz** – Prosecco, Italicus bergamot liqueur, lime, mint, on the rocks

**Moscato (Stella. Italy)** - *Lightly effervescent, semi-sweet white wine, with notes of ripe peach, apricot, and a hint of citrus.*

**Pastis & Orange Spritz** – Ricard Pastis (France), muddled orange, seltzer

**Fiol Sparkling Rosé Prosecco (Italy)** – *this stand-out “champagne” of prosecco stands out for its elegance and freshness*

	<i>60% Frontenac Gris, 40% La Crescent. Macerated pink and gold grape clusters together for ten days until pressed. The extended maceration results in an aromatic and compelling wine that is an authentic expression of the deep gravel-loam soils studded with crystals of teal fluorite.</i>	
302	Co-Fermented Red Grape/Apple Rosé – <i>Pomme Pink</i> (2022). NOK VINO. Concord	15/59
	<i>A fun, zingy rosé. It’s a dance of apples and grapes, harmonious and refreshing! Red grapes are fermented with apples from 70+ year-old trees; bottled in early spring to capture the bright flavors of both fruits, just in time to enjoy warmer weather.</i>	
303	Apple Grape Wine – <i>Golden Solera</i> (2024). NOK VINO. Concord	22/75
	<i>Crafted from a blending method known as “Solera” or Perpetual. Each late summer, a portion is bottled for wine, leaving the barrel half empty. Then, in Autumn, the barrel is topped off with new wine from that year’s harvest, resulting in a complex wine.</i>	
304	Sparkling Apple Grape Wine – <i>Suspended in Gold</i> (2022). NOK VINO. Concord	24/79
	<i>Fermenting apples and grapes together is a regional style of wine here in New England, born from the desire to infuse the elegant complexity of grapes into the abundance of apples we harvest each season. This wine is an ode to creating something new from time-honored traditions, expanding the idea of what wine can and should be.</i>	
305	Red Blend – <i>Elevation</i> (2022). NOK VINO. Concord	89
	<i>A remarkable field blend of 6 red grape varieties, grown at Mountain View Vineyard in western NH. This epic vineyard is an intense site, with winds roaring across the 100-mile, vines rooted in deep clay-shale soil on a steep slope drenched in sunlight.</i>	
306	Marquette (100%) – <i>Meadow Marquette</i> (2022). Mermaid Hill Vineyard. NOK VINO. Concord	109
	<i>A single vineyard blend grown in sandy loam studded with iron-rich stones, showcasing the potential of this austere soil to produce energetic and enigmatic wine. A concentrated expression of fruit and earth, a tension between vibrancy and tenacity.</i>	

## ***ROSÉ WINES***

---

By Glass/Bottle

- 401 Rosé: Cabernet Sauvignon (2024)(92 pts. WE). Steininger Wines. Austria 49  
*Lemon and hints of strawberry compote are appetizing on the nose. The palate comes in with zingy freshness that lifts and brightens the entire wine. The lemon finish is bone dry and vivid.*
- 402 Rosé (Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre) – *Love You Bunches* (2024)(91 pts. WE). Stolpman. Los Olivos - California 48  
*Precise and popping with bright energy. A scrumptious rosé. Strawberry married with cool, firm peach. Breezy lemon-lime and lifting mint combine effortlessly through the light and playful palate. Smooth, with just a hint of refreshing tang on the finish*
- 403 Rosé: Pinot Noir (2024). Anne Amie. Willamette Valley, Oregon 16/62  
*This dry rosé features a mineral-driven body with notes of strawberry, orange blossom, rhubarb, and a hint of honey.*
- 404 Rosé: Txakolina (2024)(90 pts. Vinous). Senorio de Astobiza. Txakoli (Basque Region) - Spain 15/52  
*Hondarrabi Beltza (black) and Hondarrabi Zuri (white) grapes. A lovely floral nose of strawberries and white flowers is followed by a clean and dry palate offering fresh acidity. Balanced minerality from the soil, long aromatic finish.*

## ***SKIN-CONTACT or “ORANGE” WINES***

---

- 405 Macabeo – “Maceración”. Parajes del Valle. Murcia - Spain 15/57  
*A bright and textural orange wine. It bursts with tangerine, melon, and nutty notes lifted by fresh citrus, offering a perfect balance of elegance and vibrancy. The subtle tannic grip adds a waxy texture and a lingering slightly bitter Campari-like edge, making it a refreshing and versatile wine.*
- 406 Pinot Blanc Cuvée (40% Chard., 10% Pinot Gris) - *Leptir* (2022). Sanctum Wines. Slovenia 13/42  
*This youthful orange wine opens with spicy aromas of dry wildflowers, apricots, pears and white tea with honey. The palate is bright, and the skin tannins are not aggressive. Earthy mid-palate leads to a long savory finish..*

## ***SLIGHTLY CHILLED RED WINES***

---

- 407 Nerello Mascalese – *Susucaru* (2022)(94 pts. WE). Frank Cornelissen. Etna – Sicily 129  
*85% Nerello Mascalese with the remainder split between Nerello Capuccio, Alicante Bouquet, Minella and Uva Francesca. The juice is fermented with indigenous yeasts and remains in contact with the skins for 60 days. The aging takes place in neutral tanks made of epoxy. Full of personality – vibrant aromas of brambly berries, herbs, and ash, with crunchy flavors of pomegranate and cranberry. Smokey minerality lingers. Cleansing acidity and fine tannins guide across the palate,*
- 408 Syrah Cuvée – *Crunchy Rôastie* (2022)(91 pts. WE). Stolpman. Los Olivos - CA 21/73  
*This blend of Syrah (95%) and Viognier (5%) offers super fresh aromas of strawberry, carnation, rose and flaky pastry for a very approachable nose. There's a firm, if quick, tannic edge to the palate of strawberry paste, pomegranate, and white-pepper.*

## ***SAKE***

---

- 409 HeavenSake – “Urakasumi” Junmai Daiginjo; 24 (5 oz)  
*Masterfully composed by acclaimed French cellar master Régis Camus, made in collaboration with Japan's most respected sake brewers. The smoothest sake possible. The highest standards of balance, purity and refinement.*

## WHITE WINES

---

- 501 Albariño – “Flor de Verano” (2023). Bodegas Tomada de Castro. Rías Baixas -Spain 46  
*Notes of citrus, green apple, pear and a stony minerality. It drinks beautifully alongside grilled veggies or seafood.*
- 502 Blanc de Blancs – “La Cuvée d’Astéria” (2022). Chateau Kefraya. Bekaa Valley – Lebanon 66  
*Named for the Greek Goddess Astéria, this a typical blend of Viognier, Chardonnay, Muscat Blanc à Petits Brains and Sauvignon Blanc expresses floral notes of lily and acacia, mingled with flavors of honey, apricot and mango. Extremely fresh.*
- 503 Blanc de Noir – “Blindfold” The Prisoner (2021) (92 pts WE). The Prisoner Wine Co. Sonoma – CA 82  
*Still, white-pressed pinot noir with notes of fresh, in-season citrus, white flower, white peach, a hint of tart cranberry. Delicate but lively, elegant, zesty & bright. This wine is made from mostly pinot noir with small amounts of Viognier and Gewürztraminer.*
- 504 Bordeaux (89 pts WE) - Lune Blanche (2022). Clos de Lunes. Pessac-Léognan - France 16/54  
*A blend of 70% Sémillon, 30% Sauvignon Blanc. Bright acidity and vibrant fruitiness. Delicious and a pleasant floral character.*
- 505 Burgundy – Saint-Veran - En Messie (100% Chardonnay)(2021). Daniel Pollier. France 17/57  
*The nose is very subtle with dried fruit and hazelnut predominating. The palate is very pleasant with freshness and balance.*
- 506 Chardonnay (2023)(90 pts WE). Netzl. Austria 19/69  
*Unoaked. Organic. In the fragrance, a combination of exotic fruit and spice, juicy pear, fresh limes, on the palate the juicy fruit is pushed into the foreground by a pleasant acid structure, creamy and long-lasting on the finish – a classic*
- 507 Chardonnay - Kith & Kin (2023). Round Pond Estate. Russian River Valley – California 16/62  
*Medium-bodied. Stainless steel fermented. Fresh aromas of ripe pear with a touch of orange blossom. Stone fruit and Golden apple flavors are balanced with bright notes of lemon zest and a bit of minerality. Balanced acidity, long finish.*
- 508 Chardonnay – Santa Rita Hills (2020)(92 pts. WE). Sea Smoke. Central Coast - California 174  
*A concentrated white peach element plays strongly on the nose of this coveted bottling, with touches of sea salt and a sharp tangerine-like edge. Ripe peach and cherimoya flavors show on the palate, but a crescendoing citrus-driven acidity cuts through the richness and allows more savory components like salt and smoked nut to blossom on the finish.*
- 509 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc (2022)(92 pts. WE). La Nerthe. Rhône Valley - France 76  
*Hints of toast and spice accent fresh yellow apple in a densely structured blend of Grenache Blanc, Roussanne, Clairette and Bourboulenc. Rich and voluminous on the palate, brightened by lemon notes and minerality.*
- 510 Chenin Blanc (2024)(88 pts WE). Kumusha. Breedekloof – South Africa 42  
*Fresh, fruity and inviting, with enticing aromas of juicy Bartlett pear, Honeycrisp apple and mandarin that fill the nose. Light weight and clean on the sip, with a bright citrus edge that continues to a refreshing finish.*
- 511 Clairette Blanche Cuvée – Beautiful Earth (2023)(94 pts WE). McPrice Myers. Paso Robles - CA 89  
*Blended with Grenache Blanc, this is a balanced, refreshing and exciting wine that begins with fresh aromas of kiwi, honeysuckle, and crushed seashell on the tight nose. A chalky grip grabs hold of the palate with engaging ripe melon and mint.*
- 512 Gewürztraminer – Estate Vineyard (2023). Gundlach Bundschu. Sonoma - California 18/62  
*Regenerative Organic. On the nose, aromas of orange blossom. First, savor the vibrant citrus notes of grapefruit, and yuzu. Then, a subtle warmth of nutmeg complements the tropical medley of papaya, pineapple guava, and a hint of tangy tamarind.*
- 513 Grüner Veltliner - Loisium (2021)(91 pts WE). Steininger. Kamptal - Austria 22/72  
*Generous tropical and orchard fruits on the nose – Asian pear, melon and banana, surrounded by peppery Grüner spice and a touch of fresh herbs. On the palate; gorgeous acidity driving to a beautiful, lingering finish.*

- 514 Moschofilero – “Feast” (2024). Seméli. Greece 14/52  
*A favorite of dining guests! Elegant aromas of rose petals, lemon blossom and citrus. Fruity driven, refreshing mouthfeel, balanced with medium acidity. Terrific with all seafoods or as an aperitif.*
- 515 Pinot Blanc (2023). Girasole. Mendocino, California 14/50  
*Beautiful pale lemon yellow, with aromas of lychee fruit, white peach, mandarin orange and zesty lemon marmalade. Its entry is crisp and lively, followed by an ample, medium-bodied mid-palate. It finishes with an invigoratingly lively crispness!*
- 516 Pinot Grigio (2024). Famiglia Castellani. Tuscany - Italy 12/44  
*Balanced bouquet with notes of apple, peach and white flowers. Fresh and harmonious on the palate. Great with fish or vegetables.*
- 517 Pinot Gris - Big Fire (2024)(90 pts). R. Stuart & Co. Winery. Willamette Valley - Oregon 59  
*This is a very giving Pinot Gris, launching with a nose of Granny Smith apple, citron and green tea with honey. The medium-bodied structure gathers up pineapple, almond and more honey, setting the table for a zesty finish of lemon and apple.*
- 518 Riesling (2021)(90 pts. WE). Ravines Cellars. Geneva (Finger Lakes) – New York 15/52  
*Sustainable. A truly bone-dry Riesling that is uncharacteristically austere. A lean, light body and a mineral laden, wet-stone palate. Lots of freshly squeezed lime and a citrus rind finish makes this an elegant, drinkable choice.*
- 519 Roussanne Cuvée – “The Flame Lily” (2022)(90 pts WE). Kumusha. Slanghoek – South Africa 89  
*A blend of Roussanne (57%), Chenin Blanc (35%), Semillon (4%), Colombar (4%). Apple, white peach, lemon zest and winter melon flavors. Complements rich white meat and Asian inspired dishes.*
- 520 Sancerre (sustainable)(2023). Henri Bourgeois. Loire Valley – France 79  
*Precise and dynamic. Delicately balancing the crispness of Sauvignon Blanc with the elegance of its terroir. An expressive nose of citrus and pineapple heralds a round and vibrant palate with hints of eucalyptus, culminating in a fresh and mineral finish.*
- 521 Sauvignon Blanc – Locations NZ (2022)(92 pts JS). Locations by Dave Phinney. New Zealand 15/59  
*Dave Phinney sought to bring the best of New Zealand in one bottle, selecting grapes from the valleys of Wairau, Awatere, and Waikopai. The wine opens with an intense bouquet of gooseberries, feijoas, and ripe tropical fruits. The bright entry of fresh cut grass and preserved lemon lead to passionfruit pot de creme showcasing a long finish of fresh herbs and clean minerality.*
- 522 Sauvignon Blanc (2024)(91 pts WE). Stolpman. Santa Barbara County - California 18/70  
*There's a delicate guava peel and passionfruit pairing to the nose of this lightly tropical bottling, but a lime-like sharpness as well. The palate is flashy and texturally exciting, enlivening the mouth and offering both tropical and citrusy flavors at once.*
- 523 Verdejo (organic)(2019)(88 pts WE). Cuatro Rayas. Rueda - Spain 49  
*A slightly yeasty aroma melds with apple and citrus on the nose. The plump palate is balanced by zesty acidity, while flavors of melon, apple and pineapple are in charge.*
- 524 Vermentino & Colombana Cuvée – Fonte delle Donne (2022)(91 pts WE). Fibbiano. Tuscany 51  
*Lovely, tangy. Aromas of yellow stone fruit, citrus, and Mediterranean herbs. Savory palate. Fresh acidity accompanies ripe apricot, grapefruit and almond before an orange drop candy close.*
- 525 Vinho Verde (Loureiro, Arinto, Trajadura) – Bocado (2023). Quinta das Arcas. Portugal 44  
*Bright, lemony color. Fruity and fresh aroma with evident green apple. The flavor has soft minerality and good balance.*
- 526 Viognier – Wyldvin Vineyard (2023). Meadowcroft. Dry Creek Valley - California 59  
*Crafted in the traditional Northern Rhône style, with a new world edge, this supple and balanced wine was aged in French-oak after being stainless-steel fermented. This lively white opens in a flourish of dried apricot, honey and passionfruit. On the palate crisp clean acidity is mingled with flavors of baked apple and notes of bergamot.*

## RED WINES

---

- 601 Agiorgitiko – “Feast” (2024). Seméli. Greece 14/52  
*Dry. Dense and intense aromas of fresh forest fruits, strawberries and cherries. Silky and harmonious with vibes, and a characteristic and balanced finish.*
- 602 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico (2017)(93 pts WE). Nicolis. Veneto - Italy 129  
*Corvina 65% – Rondinella 20% – Molinara 5% Croatina 10%. Deep dark ruby red which turns into garnet. Powerful and aristocratic nose made of ripe fruit, jam, sensations of cocoa, walnut, tobacco, and leather. Elegant and powerful wine with a spicy bouquet of distinct flavors; an impressive balance between volume and smoothness, warmth and crispness, austerity, and richness.*
- 603 Barbaresco (2017)(90 pts WE). Luigi Voghera. Piedmont - Italy 99  
*This leads with menthol, new leather, exotic spice and balsamic notes. The concentrated palate offers dried black cherry, tobacco and star anise flavors set against firm, fine-grained tannins and bright acidity.*
- 604 Barolo – “Lecinguevigne” (2021)(DOCG)(91 pts. WE). Damilano. Italy 129  
*A fine-tuned, elegant Barolo with aromas of dried cherries, dried roses, licorice and mint. Full-bodied, it shows smoothness, density, weight and soft tannins despite the structure, with refreshing acidity and a long, vibrant finish full of savory flavors.*
- 605 Blaufränkisch – (2019)(93 pts WE). Hillinger. Burgenland, Austria 59  
*Intense black, purple color with a very short rim, the nose is very complex with lots of blackberries, bilberries, cherry, and dried fruit. On top, the perfectly integrated roasted aromas are supported by the typical spice. Very long finish, grippy tannins.*
- 606 Bordeaux Red - "Trintaudon" Cru Borgeois (91 pts WE). Chateau Larose. Haut- Médoc 74  
*An elegant, fruity blend of 58% Merlot and 42% Cabernet. The wine comes from vines on the edge of the Pauillac appellation, with deep gravel soil that gives structure to the approachable black fruits. Wine Enthusiast “Editor’s Choice”.*

*Aromas of forest floor, oak-driven spice, crushed aromatic herb and blue flower slowly appear in the glass. On the rounded, full-bodied palate, taut, fine-grained tannins and fresh acidity accompany juicy black cherry, coffee bean and licorice.*

*Deep maroon. Aromas of wild blackberry, pepper, raisin cookie, Sequoia forest, bay leaf, and spices. The entry is broad and opulent with a mid-palate of brambly raspberry, black cherry, blueberry, and a hint of cacao. Ripe tannins and sweet oak on the long finish.*
- 643 Zweigelt (cuvée) – *Ried Bärnreiser Anna Christina* (2016)(94 pts WE). Netzl. Austria 169  
*Very elegant. Organic. Zweigelt blended with Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Dark plum, chocolate and graphite on the nose still need to unfurl fully. The dense palate is tightly wound and bound in its firm but fine structure of drying, taut tannins.*
