ROSÉ WINES

By Glass/Bottle

- 401 Rosé: Cabernet Sauvignon (2021)(92 pts. WE). Steininger Wines. Austria 14/49
Lemon and hints of strawberry compote are appetizing on the nose. The palate comes in with zingy freshness that lifts and brightens the entire wine. The lemon finish is bone dry and vivid.
- 402 Rosé: Cinsault (2021)(90 pts WE). Kumusha. Breedekloof – South Africa 12/42
Aromas of bright red fruit with cherry and strawberry flavours showing off. Notes of subtle floral and dry spice adding character. This wine is best with food to bring forward its full character.
- 403 Pinot Noir “White” (2022). Anthony Nappa. North Fork - Long Island 14/52
Bright aromas of grapefruit, candied banana, guava and crushed stone start off this energized rosé. The medium-bodied palate shows a deft mix of tart citrus and rounded tropical fruit balanced. Zesty, citrusy acidity pushes through on a lingering finish.
- 404 Rosé: Txakolina (2022)(90 pts. Vinous). Senorio de Astobiza. Txakoli (Basque Region) - Spain 14/52
Hondarrabi Beltza (black) and Hondarrabi Zuri (white) grapes. A lovely floral nose of strawberries and white flowers is followed by a clean and dry palate offering fresh acidity. Balanced minerality from the soil, long aromatic finish.

SKIN-CONTACT or “ORANGE” WINES

- 405 La Crescent (unfiltered) - Tectonic. Iapetus. Vermont 79
The aroma is complex and layered, with notes of apricot, peach, raisin, white pepper, tea, rose water, and floral attributes; you could keep your nose in this all-day. This vintage is light-bodied and has delicacy and balance. On the palate, Tectonic's tannin and acidity are integrated, with a tartness and texture reminiscent of tea and thick-skinned tropical fruits.
- 406 Pinot Blanc Cuvée (40% Chardonnay, 10% Pinot Gris) – Leptir (2019). Sanctum Wines. Slovenia 12/42
This youthful orange wine opens with spicy aromas of dry wildflowers, apricots, pears and white tea with honey. The palate is bright, and the skin tannins are not aggressive. Earthy mid-palate leads to a long savory finish.

SLIGHTLY CHILLED RED WINES

- 407 Nerello Mascalese – Susucaru (2017)(94 pts. WE). Frank Cornelissen. Etna – Sicily 34/129
85% Nerello Mascalese with the remainder split between Nerello Capuccio, Alicante Bouquet, Minella and Uva Francesca. The juice is fermented with indigenous yeasts and remains in contact with the skins for 60 days. The aging takes place in neutral tanks made of epoxy. Full of personality – vibrant aromas of brambly berries, herbs, and ash, with crunchy flavors of pomegranate and cranberry. Smokey minerality lingers. Cleansing acidity and fine tannins guide across the palate,
- 408 Syrah Cuvée – Crunchy Rôastie (2022)(91 pts. WE). Stolpman. Los Olivos - CA 20/73
This blend of Syrah (95%) and Viognier (5%) offers super fresh aromas of strawberry, carnation, rose and flaky pastry for a very approachable nose. There's a firm, if quick, tannic edge to the palate of strawberry paste, pomegranate, and white-pepper.

SAKE FLIGHT

- 409 HeavenSake Trio – “Katsuyama Junmai Ginjo Azur; “Urakasumi” Junmai Daiginjo; “Konishi” Junmai 12. - \$49 for flight of 3 (3.5 oz pours); \$24 for 5 oz. pour of one selection
Masterfully composed by acclaimed French cellar master Régis Camus, made in collaboration with Japan's most respected sake brewers. The smoothest sake possible. The highest standards of balance, purity and refinement.

WHITE WINES

- 501 Blanc de Blancs – “La Cuvée d’Astéria” (2022). Chateau Kefraya. Bekaa Valley – Lebanon 66
Named for the Greek Goddess Astéria, this a typical blend of Viognier, Chardonnay, Muscat Blanc à Petits Brains and Sauvignon Blanc expresses floral notes of lily and acacia, mingled with flavors of honey, apricot and mango. Extremely fresh.
- 502 Blanc de Noir – “Blindfold” The Prisoner (2021) (92 pts WE). The Prisoner Wine Co. Sonoma 22/82
Still, white-pressed pinot noir with notes of fresh, in-season citrus, white flower, white peach, a hint of tart cranberry. Delicate but lively, elegant, zesty & bright. This wine is made from mostly pinot noir with small amounts of Viognier and Gewürztraminer.
- 503 Bordeaux (89 pts WE) - Lune Blanche. Clos de Lunes. Pessac-Léognan - France 14/54
A blend of 70% Sémillon, 30% Sauvignon Blanc. Bright acidity and vibrant fruitiness. Delicious and a pleasant floral character.
- 504 Burgundy – Saint-Veran – En Messie. Daniel Pollier. France 15/57
100% Chardonnay. The nose is very subtle with dried fruit and hazelnut predominating. The palate is very pleasant with freshness and balance.
- 505 Chardonnay (2022)(90 pts WE). Netzl. Austria 17/69
Unoaked. Organic. In the fragrance, a combination of exotic fruit and spice, juicy pear, fresh limes, on the palate the juicy fruit is pushed into the foreground by a pleasant acid structure, creamy and long-lasting on the finish – a classic
- 506 Chardonnay - Pacificana (2022)(90 pts WE). Winc Wines. Acampo (Central Coast) – CA 12/44
This bold and engaging Chardonnay showcases classic California styles for the next generation of wine enthusiasts. It isn't the oak bomb style of ten years ago; instead, it strikes the perfect balance between richness and elegance.
- 507 Chardonnay Cuvée - The Prisoner “Carneros” (2019). The Prisoner Wine Co. Oakville - CA 109
This blend of Chardonnay, Roussanne and Gewürztraminer presents a pale color with aromas of stone and citrus fruits with toast oak. On the palate, flavors of crisp apple and peach with citrus zest and nutty vanilla notes. Well balanced with acidity. Medium finish with fruit, oak, and mineral character.
- 508 Chardonnay – Santa Rita Hills (2020)(92 pts. WE). Sea Smoke. Central Coast - CA 174
A concentrated white peach element plays strongly on the nose of this coveted bottling, with touches of sea salt and a sharp tangerine-like edge. Ripe peach and cherimoya flavors show on the palate, but a crescendoing citrus-driven acidity cuts through the richness and allows more savory components like salt and smoked nut to blossom on the finish.
- 509 Chenin Blanc (2021)(88 pts WE). Breedekloof 11/42
Fresh, fruity and inviting, with enticing aromas of juicy Bartlett pear, Honeycrisp apple and mandarin that fill the nose. Light weight and clean on the sip, with a bright citrus edge that continues to a refreshing finish.
- 510 Clairette Blanche (54%), Grenache Blanc (46%) – Beautiful Earth (2019)(94 pts WE). McPrice Myers. Paso Robles 20/76
A balanced, refreshing and exciting blend begins with fresh and even minty aromas of honeysuckle, kiwi and crushed seashell on the tight nose. A chalky grip grabs hold of the palate with engaging ripe melon and mint.
- 511 Gewürztraminer (2020)(91 pts WE). Ravines Cellars. Geneva (Finger Lakes) - NY 17/62
Rich layers of rose petal, apricot, lychee and spiced pear intermingle with white pepper and sweet spices. Driving acidity is balanced by an elegant, fresh and enduring finish. Lovely aromatics.
- 512 Grüner Veltliner – Dürnstein T26. Federspiel. (2020)(90 pts. WE). Tegernseerhof. Austria 14/48
A touch of white pepper surrounds the green pear peel hints on the nose. The palate comes in with balanced lightness that is juice and fresh, helped along by gentle spritz. This is easy, juicy, balanced, and dry.

- 513 Pinela (2021). Pikasi Wines. Vipava Valley - Slovenia 13/46
Dry white. Elegant aromas of white peach, wildflowers and almonds. Pleasant creaminess and savory mouthwatering minerality.
- 514 Pinot Blanc (Weißburgunder) – Altenberg (2019)(93 pts. WE). Netzl. Carnuntum 20/76
A touch of hazelnut and smoke accompanies the flowing green and yellow apple notes on the nose of this wine. The palate adds a touch of yeasty richness without distorting its svelte translucency in the slightest. The apple notes are free to swirl against this finely tuned backdrop. The finish is dry, fresh, yeasty, fruity, and long.
- 515 Pinot Grigio (2022). Famiglia Castellani. Tuscany - Italy 12/44
Balanced bouquet with notes of apple, peach and white flowers. Fresh and harmonious on the palate. Great with fish or vegetables.
- 516 Pinot Gris - O.P.P. - Other People's Pinot Gris (2023). Maison Noir. Oregon 15/59
Dry, lively and refreshing with flavors of crisp pear, green apple, and a hint of citrus. Bright acidity and a smooth, clean finish.
- 517 Riesling (2021)(90 pts. WE). Ravines Cellars. Geneva (Finger Lakes) - NY 14/52
Sustainable. A truly bone-dry Riesling that is uncharacteristically austere. A lean, light body and a mineral laden, wet-stone palate. Lots of freshly squeezed lime and a citrus rind finish makes this an elegant, drinkable choice.
- 518 Roussanne Cuvée (2021)(91 pts IWR). L'Ermite D'Auzan. Costières de Nîmes – France 12/42
A blend of Roussanne (60%), Grenache Blanc (20%) and Viognier (20%), this fresh-fruited dry white wine is the perfect balance between lush stone fruit and lemon acidity. Three months in new French oak lend smoky nutmeg and vanilla accents.
- 519 Sancerre (sustainable)(2023). Henri Bourgeois. Loire Valley – France 19/79
Precise and dynamic. Delicately balancing the crispness of Sauvignon Blanc with the elegance of its terroir. An expressive nose of citrus and pineapple heralds a round and vibrant palate with hints of eucalyptus, culminating in a fresh and mineral finish.
- 520 Sauvignon Blanc – Locations NZ (2022)(92 pts JS). Locations by Dave Phinney. New Zealand 15/59
Dave Phinney sought to bring the best of New Zealand in one bottle, selecting grapes from the valleys of Wairau, Awatere, and Waikopai. The wine opens with an intense bouquet of gooseberries, feijoas, and ripe tropical fruits. The bright entry of fresh cut grass and preserved lemon lead to passionfruit pot de creme showcasing a long finish of fresh herbs and clean minerality.
- 521 Verdejo (organic)(2019)(88 pts WE). Cuatro Rayas. Rueda - Spain 13/49
A slightly yeasty aroma melds with apple and citrus on the nose. The plump palate is balanced by zesty acidity, while flavors of melon, apple and pineapple are in charge.
- 522 Vermentino & Colombana Cuvée – Fonte delle Donne (2021)(91 pts WE). Fibbiano. Tuscany 14/51
Lovely, tangy. Aromas of yellow stone fruit, citrus, and Mediterranean herbs. Savory palate. Fresh acidity accompanies ripe apricot, grapefruit and almond before an orange drop candy close.
- 523 Vinho Verde – Bico do (2022). Quinta das Arcas. Portugal 12/44
Bright, lemony color. Fruity and fresh aroma with evident green apple. The flavor has soft minerality and good balance.
- 524 Viognier – Wyldvin Vineyard (2023). Meadowcroft. Dry Creek Valley - CA 16/59
Crafted in the traditional Northern Rhône style, with a new world edge, this supple and balanced wine was aged in French-oak after being stainless-steel fermented. This lively white opens in a flourish of dried apricot, honey and passionfruit. On the palate crisp clean acidity is mingled with flavors of baked apple and notes of bergamot.
- 525 Vouvray – Réserve du Naufraget (2023). Philippe de Guéros. Loire Valley – France 14/52
This fresh medium dry Chenin Blanc has wonderful aromas of honey and acacia underlined with refreshing acidity. A sweet sensation and dry finish on the palate. Concentrated rich flavors develop fruity aromas such as orange peel, honey and quince.

RED WINES

- 601 Amaranone della Valpolicella Classico (2012)(93 pts WE). Nicolis. Veneto - Italy 129
Corvina 65% – Rondinella 20% – Molinara 5% Croatina 10%. Deep dark ruby red which turns into garnet. Powerful and aristocratic nose made of ripe fruit, jam, sensations of cocoa, walnut, tobacco, and leather. Elegant and powerful wine with a spicy bouquet of distinct flavors; an impressive balance between volume and smoothness, warmth and crispness, austerity, and richness.
- 602 Barbaresco (2013)(90 pts WE). Luigi Voghera. Piedmont - Italy 99
This leads with menthol, new leather, exotic spice and balsamic notes. The concentrated palate offers dried black cherry, tobacco and star anise flavors set against firm, fine-grained tannins and bright acidity.
- 603 Barolo (2013)(DOCG)(91 pts. WE). Réva. Monforte D'Alba. Italy 129
Rose petal, red-skinned berry and leather aromas take center stage. The juicy palate offers Morello cherry, clove and white pepper alongside taut fine-grained tannins.
- 604 Blaufränkisch – Leitberg (2020)(93 pts WE). Hillinger. Burgenland, Austria 15/59
Intense black, purple color with a very short rim, the nose is very complex with lots of blackberries, bilberries, cherry, and dried fruit. On top, the perfectly integrated roasted aromas are supported by the typical spice. Very long finish, grippy tannins.
- 605 Bordeaux Red Blend – *Pentimento* (2014). Chateau Beausejour. St. Émilion - France 19/72
75 Merlot/25 Cab Franc. From Michele D'Aprix, the only female American winemaker in Bordeaux! Nose of dark chocolate, espresso, black plums, raspberry, and baking spice. Palate is grippy, woody, black fruit and sweet oak. Dry finish.
- 606 Bordeaux Red (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot). Chateau Pauillac. Pauillac - France 104
Ruby color. Charming nose dominated by violets, round and velvety on the palate with black fruit aromas. Silky and delightful. Delicate on the finish, tannins are ripe and rich. Long finish.
- 607 Brunello di Montalcino (2018)(91 pts WS). Albatreti. Tuscany -Italy 179
Aromas of forest floor, oak-driven spice, crushed aromatic herb and blue flower slowly appear in the glass. On the rounded, full-bodied palate, taut, fine-grained tannins and fresh acidity accompany juicy black cherry, coffee bean and licorice.
- 608 Burgundy – *Old Vine Pinot Noir* (2020)(92 pts WE). Albert Bichot. Beaune - France 16/58
Old vines. Flattering nose with an appealing palette of fruity aromas (black currant, red currant, plum). Fleshy and balanced.
- 609 Cabernet Franc “Bordo Antico” (89 pts. WE). Anthony Nappa. North Fork - Long Island 18/65
A gentle spiced cranberry aroma starts off this red, with fresh herbal accents of thyme and savory chiming in. It's driven by tart red berry flavors on the palate, flecked by dried chile and herbs. Light rustic tannins and mild acidity lend support.
- 610 Cabernet Sauvignon Cuvée (2021). Bold Wine Company. Paso Robles - CA 15/56
Bold, yet still showing restraint, this Cabernet is blended with Malbec and Petit Verdot. Red currants, blue plums, black cherries, granite and a light touch of refreshing mintiness are supported by firm-yet-smooth tannins.
- 611 Cabernet Sauvignon – *Gigglepot* (2021)(90 pts WS) 106
Elegant balance; layers of sweet fruit rolling over dark chocolate; rich, creamy palate with grand finish.
- 612 Cabernet Sauvignon – *Double Back* (2019)(94 pts). Bledsoe Family. Columbia Valley - Washington 344
Drew Bledsoe's retirement plan, after 14 years as an NFL quarterback, Doubleback brought him back to his hometown of Walla Walla to make wine. Crushed rock aromas open on a savory note, joining complex veins of dark fruit wrapped in tobacco leaf and mint. Vibrant energy and impressive structure; lovely berry fruit balanced with crushed herbs.

- 613 Cabernet Sauvignon - Estate (2020)(92 pts WE). Ghost Block. Oakville – California 189
Organic. 5% Malbec and 5% Petit Verdot. Opens on a perfumed nose of sage, lavender and rose petal. Persistent tones of clove and baking spice complement the brooding blackberry and sanguine notes. Medium bodied with an elegant finish.
- 614 Cabernet Sauvignon (Cabernet Franc and Merlot) – Mercury Head (2018). Orin Swift. Napa 294
Aromatics of plum and cherry, dark chocolate, leather and Rutherford Dust coalesce from the glass. The entry is elegant and floods the palate with notes of cassia, blackberry, blueberry, caramel and a touch of cinnamon and brown sugar. Dusty tannins.
- 615 Cabernet Sauvignon – Papillon (2018)(90 pts RP). Orin Swift. Napa 212
It's rare to find a Napa Valley wine composed of all five Bordeaux-style varietals! The raw strength and prestige of Cabernet Sauvignon buttressed by the opulence of Merlot, the spiciness of Cabernet Franc, the depth of Malbec and the sheer unctuousness of Petit Verdot come together seamlessly.
- 616 Cabernet Sauvignon Cuvée – Assemblage (2014)(93 pts. WE). Paumanok. N. Fork - Long Island 125
Bordeaux-style blend of Cab. Sauv. with Merlot, Cab. Franc, and Petit Verdot. Decadent yet finessed, this intensely ripe wine brims with fleshy flavors of black plum and cassia. Tart cranberry acidity and complexities of olive, savory spice and granite.
- 617 Cabernet Sauvignon & Cinsault Cuvée (2021). Kumusha Wines. Slanghoek – South Africa 14/52
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (75%) and Cinsault (25%). Ripe cherry and plum flavors, with hints of pomegranate and strawberry. Complements all types of juicy red meat dishes, especially slow-cooked ones.
- 618 Carignane Cuvée - Coquille Rouge (2018)(93 pts. WE). Carol Shelton. Sonoma - CA 15/59
Rhône Valley inspired. Stunning blend of Carignane and Grenache Noir bring tangy red fruit, Mourvedre fills in with savory gaminess, Alicante Bouschet adds spicy blueberry fruit (and color!), and Petite Sirah gives peppery backbone.
- 619 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge – Secret Barville (2016)(95 pts. WE). Brotte. Rhône Valley 132
Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre create a rich, undulating blend with firm tannins. Studded with glossy blueberry and black-cherry flavors, its and intense, brooding wine shaded by hints of crushed earth and coffee grinds.
- 620 Chianti Classico Riserva (2017)(DOCG). Famiglia Castellani. Pontedera (Tuscany) - Italy 13/49
Deep ruby red. Rich with notes of cherries, plums, and iris. Deep cherry and leather flavors with subtle wood notes. Supple tannins, good acidity, and a lingering finish. Perfect with flavorful roasts, pastas, and cheeses.
- 621 Grenache Cuvée (Syrah, Mourvedre) – Cherries & Rainbows (2020). Languedoc - France 13/49
Sulfite-free. Organic. Plum, dark cherry, boysenberry, blackberry, violet, sage, forest floor, menthol, eucalyptus and black licorice.
- 622 Grenache Cuvée (Syrah, Petite Sirah) - Abstract (2016)(92 pts WS). Orin Swift. Napa 24/89
Aromatic notes of Luxardo cherries, ripe black plums and raspberries billow, with intricate hints of coffee, mocha and caramel. The entry is expansive with dark briar fruits, cola and cocoa with soft tannins. Finishes with a sweet oak presence.
- 623 Malbec. Vinyes Ocults by Tomás Stahringer. Valle de Uco, Mendoza – Argentina 13/49
Enticing aromas of cedar and violets lead to a full-bodied and smooth palate. There is a good amount of black fruit and herbs in this wine. It's juicy and has a solid structure holding it all together.
- 624 Malbec - Finca Pirca (2012)(88 pts.WS). Familia Mayol. Mendoza – Argentina 96
High Altitude Malbec (3,478 feet above from Uco Valley). Aromas of blackberry, violets and a hint of graphite. Fresh fruit and smoky notes on the midpalate give way to a balanced finish.
- 625 Merlot – Estate (2019)(87 pts. WE). Lieb Cellars. North Fork, Long Island 14/54
This rather austere Merlot delivers coiled flavors of plum and cranberry braced by earthy accents of tar, thyme and menthol. The acidity is driving it all, with fine yet copious tannins leading to a pinpoint close.

- 626 Petite Sirah, Syrah, Grenache – *Machete* (2016)(92 pts. WS). Orin Swift. Napa, CA 139
A nose of black plums, cassis, and cacao engage. A progressing palate of blackberry and boysenberry compote, a reduction of dark plum and ripe figs and pure Amarena cherry. Flashes of vanilla and traces of minerality evolve into chalky tannins on the finish.
- 627 Pinot Noir (2020)(92 pts. WE). Anton Bauer. Wagram - Austria 18/68
Precise balance between the fruit and acidity that makes it fresh and lively. A typical Pinot Noir nose with strawberries, raspberries and floral notes such as violets. The palate is well balanced, elegant, and it has a long finish tasting of red berries.
- 628 Pinot Noir (2021)(92 pts. WE). Millbrook. Millbrook – New York 125
Showing excellent lift and concentration, this Pinot delivers pleasantly rich tones of blackberry and bramble berry, with accents of menthol and crushed peppercorns. Silky in texture yet driven by fresh acidity. Floral and spice qualities arise mid-palate.
- 629 Pinot Noir – *Slander* (2019)(91 pts. Wine Advocate). Orin Swift. Napa 112
Pale to medium ruby-purple color, this wine springs from the glass with notes of raspberry tart, cranberry sauce and rhubarb pie plus hints of Provence herbs and forest floor. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is softly spoken with a nice chewiness.
- 630 Pinot Noir – *Ten* (2020)(94 pts. WE). Sea Smoke. Central Coast - California 195
Biodynamic. A brooding and intense wine. The aromas begin with notes of Elderberry, Freesia and Fig, then a myriad of savory spices, and a hint of lavender. Firm, mature tannins are followed by a long, velvety finish.
- 631 Rioja (Tempranillo - Toro) – *El Picaro* (2022)(92 pts. WE). Matsu. Spain 13/49
A young wine with fresh aromatics and full flavor. Displays good aroma intensity of blackberries and blueberries, combined with mineral notes. Fresh entry on the palate, with rich flavors, complexity and good fruit extract. Smooth and pleasant.
- 632 Rioja (Tempranillo - Toro) – *El Viejo* (2022)(92 pts. WE). Matsu. Spain 118
This deep garnet-colored wine has aromas of blackberries, cassis and dried sage. Tannins come on strong at first and then drop off to reveal black cherry, Chambord, mocha, eucalyptus and crumbled sage leaf flavors. Shimmering acidity keeps the palate aloft.
- 633 Sangiovese (2020)(87 pts. WE). Noelia Ricci. Romagna 65
Aromas of red berry and underbrush. Cheerful palate of strawberry, cinnamon and a hint of orange peel alongside smooth tannins.
- 634 Shiraz - *Blue-Eyed Boy* (2015)(92 pts WS). Mollydooker. Australia 114
Smooth, rich, and satiny; incredibly aromatic with alluring notes of blackberry, cherry, licorice, and vanilla bean.
- 635 Shiraz - *Carnival of Love* (2016)(93 pts WS). Mollydooker. Australia 215
At 85-95% fruit weight, it has elegance; an intense and seamless flavor spectrum; sumptuous mouth-feel and perfect balance. Voted "Top Wine in the World" three years in a row by Wine Enthusiast.
- 636 St. Laurent (94 pts WE)(2017). Steindorfer. Austria 20/77
Intense dark berry bouquet, well-balanced palate with rich fruit, elegant and substantial. Very memorable.
- 637 Syrah Cuvée – *Les Bretèches* (2020). Château Kefraya. Bekaa Valley - Lebanon 16/63
This blend with Cinsaut, Cabernet Sauvignon and Tempranillo, is a quintessential Lebanese wine. With a finely spiced nose of blackcurrant and cherry, it reveals silky tannins and generous red fruit flavors.
- 638 Syrah Cuvée – *La Cuadrilla* (2021)(91 pts. WE). Stolpman. Los Olivos - CA 16/62
This blend of Syrah (75%), Grenache (15%) and Sangiovese (10%), directed by and directly benefits the winery's full-time vineyard crew, begins with aromas of roasted yet crisp red fruit, rose petals and grilled meats, with an underlying carbonic tone. The palate is bright and zesty, with fresh fruits, white-pepper and charred meat flavors.

- 639 Syrah Cuvée – *Para Maria* (2021)(91 pts. WE). Stolpman. Los Olivos - CA 15/54
This blend of Syrah (80%), Petite Verdot (20%) delivers a core of red and black fruit with notes of black pepper, anise, and hints of red cherry. A dark and brooding wine.
- 640 Touriga Nacional Cuvée – *Dezoito by Maniche* (2019). Quinta da Pacheca. Dão - Portugal 20/74
A blend of Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca and Tinta Roriz. Very fruity in the aroma, with evident blackberry and plum aromas, balanced with chocolate notes provided by the barrels, shows balance in the mouth, with solid tannins and a long finish.
- 641 Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore (2020)(88 pts WE). Taveggia. Verona – Italy 19/72
Cherries, dried fruit and hints of black spice, dried cardamon and viola. Fresh with tight nit, polished tannins
- 642 Zinfandel Cuvée - *The Prisoner* (2019) (92 pts WE). The Prisoner Wine Co. Napa Valley 26/99
Inspired by the wines first made by the first Italian immigrants in Napa Valley, The Prisoner has led the resurgence of interesting blends by incorporating Zinfandel with the unlikely mix of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, Syrah, and Chabonno. Bright aromas of raspberry, vanilla, and coconut give way to flavors of blackberry, pomegranate, and vanilla; lingering and luscious finish.
- 643 Zweigelt (cuvée) – *Ried Bärreiser Anna Christina* (2016)(94 pts WE). Netzl. Austria 169
Zweigelt blended with Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Dark plum, chocolate and graphite on the nose still need to unfurl fully. The dense palate, filled to the brim with these flavors, is tightly wound and bound in its firm but fine structure of drying, taut tannins. This is elegant, sinuous, and serious – in intent, and in the pleasure it offers. Organic.
