On the palate, Tectonic's tannin and acidity are integrated, with a tartness and texture reminiscent of tea and thick-skinned tropical fruits.

Pinot Blanc Cuvée (40% Chardonnay, 10% Pinot Gris) – Leptir (2019). Sanctum Wines. Slovenia 12/42

This youthful orange wine opens with spicy aromas of dry wildflowers, apricots, pears and white tea with honey.

The palate is bright, and the skin tannins are not aggressive. Earthy mid-palate leads to a long savory finish.
