ROSÉ WINES

By Glass/Bottle

- 401 Rosé: Summer Water Bubbly (2022)(91 pts. WE). Rhône - France 15/59
Classic French rosé. Refreshing and light with just a touch of sweetness. Showcases notes of candied strawberries, watermelon, and fragrant elderflowers. A fun sparkling wine for celebrations in summer or all year round!
- 402 Rosé: Cinsault (2021)(90 pts WE). Kumusha. Breedekloof – South Africa 11/42
Aromas of bright red fruit with cherry and strawberry flavours showing off. Notes of subtle floral and dry spice adding character. This wine is best with food to bring forward its full character.
- 403 Pinot Noir “White” (2022). Anthony Nappa. North Fork - Long Island 13/50
Bright aromas of grapefruit, candied banana, guava and crushed stone start off this energized rosé. The medium-bodied palate shows a deft mix of tart citrus and rounded tropical fruit balanced. Zesty, citrusy acidity pushes through on a lingering finish.
- 404 Rosé: Rioja – Larchago (2021)(90 pts. WE). Familia Chavarri. Spain 13/50
Light apricot in color; aromas of lemon curd, guava, and button mushroom; flavors of lemon preserves, white peach, orange zest and rose petal taper into a soft floral finish.

SKIN-CONTACT or “ORANGE” WINES

- 405 La Crescent (unfiltered) - Tectonic. Iapetus. Vermont 79
The aroma is complex and layered, with notes of apricot, peach, raisin, white pepper, tea, rose water, and floral attributes; you could keep your nose in this all-day. This vintage is light-bodied and has delicacy and balance. On the palate, Tectonic's tannin and acidity are integrated, with a tartness and texture reminiscent of tea and thick-skinned tropical fruits.
- 406 Pinot Blanc Cuvée (40% Chardonnay, 10% Pinot Gris) – Leptir (2019). Sanctum Wines. Slovenia 11/42
This youthful orange wine opens with spicy aromas of dry wildflowers, apricots, pears and white tea with honey. The palate is bright, and the skin tannins are not aggressive. Earthy mid-palate leads to a long savory finish.
- 407 Picpoul Carbonique - Groundwork (2021). Sans Liege. Paso Robles - CA 12/48
Organic. Unfiltered. 90% Picpoul Blanc, 7% Malvasia, 5% Malbec. Whole cluster carbonic native yeast fermentation on skins for 14 days to create an “orange” wine. Delicious palate of orange marmalade, lemongrass, watermelon rind, lilac, and black tea.

SLIGHTLY CHILLED RED WINES

- 408 Gamay – Keep It Chill (2019). Cooperatively Harvested in France. Bottled by Winc. in CA. 13/50
Sustainable. A refreshing, vibrant style with brambly flavors that pop when the temperature drops. Abundant red fruit aromas.
- 409 Nerello Mascalese – Susucaru (2017)(94 pts. WE). Frank Cornelissen. Etna – Sicily 27/129
A field blend of local varietals from all of Frank's vineyards on Mt. Etna. It is 85% Nerello Mascalese with the remainder split between Nerello Capuccio, Alicante Boushet, Minella and Uva Francesca. After light crushing of the grapes, the juice is fermented with indigenous yeasts and remains in contact with the skins for 60 days. The aging takes place in neutral tanks made of epoxy. Depending upon the vintage quality, little to no sulfur is added. The resulting wine is full of personality – vibrant aromas of brambly berries, herbs, and ash, with crunchy flavors of pomegranate and cranberry. Smokey minerality lingers behind the fruit. Cleansing acidity and fine-grained tannins guide the wine across the palate, making it incredibly versatile at the table. At its fullest chilled!
- 410 Syrah Cuvée – Crunchy Rôastie (2022)(91 pts. WE). Stolpman. Los Olivos - CA 19/73
This blend of Syrah (95%) and Viognier (5%) offers super fresh aromas of strawberry, carnation, rose and flaky pastry for a very approachable nose. There's a firm, if quick, tannic edge to the palate of strawberry paste, pomegranate, and white-pepper.

WHITE WINES

- 501 Blanc de Noir – “Blindfold” *The Prisoner* (2021) (92 pts WE). The Prisoner Wine Co. Sonoma 21/80
Still, white-pressed pinot noir with notes of fresh, in-season citrus, white flower, white peach, a hint of tart cranberry. Delicate but lively, elegant, zesty & bright. This wine is made from mostly pinot noir with small amounts of Viognier and Gewurztraminer.
- 502 Bordeaux White (89 pts WE) - *Lune Blanche*. Clos de Lunes. Pessac-Léognan - France 13/52
A blend of 70% Sémillon, 30% Sauvignon Blanc. Bright acidity and vibrant fruitiness. Delicious and a pleasant floral character.
- 503 Burgenlandweiß (Welchsriesling, Muscat)(2020)(89 pts WE). Meinklang. Austria 11/44
*A lovely blend of with a fragrant lift of honeysuckle and grape rises from the glass.
The palate is light and dry—still floral yet tinged with lemony freshness. Easy and bright like a summer breeze.*
- 504 Chablis (2019)(89 pts WE). Domaine du Colombier. Burgundy - France 17/69
Tart pineapple and white-grapefruit flavors introduce this fresh, easy-drinking Chablis. Ripe and juicy, the fruit-forward sip is anchored by a zesty oyster-shell minerality.
- 505 Chardonnay – *Santa Rita Hills* (2020)(92 pts. WE). Sea Smoke. Central Coast - CA 42/174
A concentrated white peach element plays strongly on the nose of this coveted bottling, with touches of sea salt and a sharp tangerine-like edge. Ripe peach and cherimoya flavors show on the palate, but a crescendoing citrus-driven acidity cuts through the richness and allows more savory components like salt and smoked nut to blossom on the finish.
- 506 Chardonnay - *Francine’s Selection* (unoaked)(2022)(90 pts WE). Toad Hollow. Mendocino – CA 11/44
Balanced acidity balances with a slight note of richness from partial malolactic fermentation. Hints of citrus, minerals, and tropical fruit make this a perfect pairing with chicken, salads, and soft approachable cheeses.
- 507 Clairette Blanche (54%), Grenache Blanc (46%) – *Beautiful Earth* (2019)(94 pts WE). McPrice Myers. Paso Robles 19/ 76
A balanced, refreshing and exciting blend begins with fresh and even minty aromas of honeysuckle, kiwi and crushed seashell on the tight nose. A chalky grip grabs hold of the palate with engaging ripe melon and mint.
- 508 Encruzado Blend – *Titular*. Reserve (2020). Caminhos Cruzados. Dão - Portugal 13/49
Encruzado, the typical white varietal from Dão, blended with Bical and Malvasia Fina and fermented in French oak barrel. Good acidity and a fresh and fruity aroma of citrus. It delivers freshness, good structure, and volume.
- 509 Pinela (2021). Pikasi Wines. Vipava Valley - Slovenia 12/46
Dry white. Elegant aromas of white peach, wildflowers and almonds. Pleasant creaminess and savory mouthwatering minerality.
- 510 Pinot Grigio (2022). Vento di Mare. Sicily - Italy 10/38
Organic. This refreshing wine reveals delicious notes of pears and citrus and delivers a fragrant, fruity finish.
- 511 Roussanne Cuvée (2021)(91 pts IWR). L’Ermitte D’Auzan. Costières de Nîmes – France 11/42
A blend of Roussanne (60%), Grenache Blanc (20%) and Viognier (20%), this fresh-fruited dry white wine is the perfect balance between lush stone fruit and lemon acidity. Three months in new French oak lend smoky nutmeg and vanilla accents.
- 512 Sauvignon Blanc – *Locations NZ* (2022)(92 pts JS). Locations by Dave Phinney. New Zealand 13/49
Dave Phinney sought to bring the best of New Zealand in one bottle, selecting grapes from the valleys of Wairau, Awatere, and Waikopai. The wine opens with an intense bouquet of gooseberries, feijoas, and ripe tropical fruits. The bright entry of fresh cut grass and preserved lemon lead to passionfruit pot de creme showcasing a long finish of fresh herbs and clean minerality.

- 513 Sauvignon Blanc (3% Muscat) - *Blank Stare* (2018) Russian River Valley 23/89
Compelling notes of spiced pears, ripe peaches, green apples and dill seed with a waft of aniseed. Medium-bodied and satiny, with a lovely line of freshness, it finishes long and lively.
- 514 Txakoli de Alava (2020)(90 pts. Vinous). Senorio de Astobiza. Txakoli (Basque Region) - Spain 13/52
95% Hondarrabi Zuri and 5% Hondarrabi Zuri Zuratie.. Delicious and brightly fresh, ripe fruit. Aromas of white pear, young peach, green apple, and fresh grapefruit lead to an extremely fresh palate that is balanced with minerality, acidity, and persistence.
- 515 Verdelho (early pick) – *Summer of '69* (2021). Mollydooker. Australia 18/ 69
This wine was created to celebrate the 50th birthday of winemaker Sarah Marquis. A bouquet of honeysuckle greets you followed by lemon and tangerine sherbert.
- 516 Verdicchio (2021). Breccia. Castelli di Jesi, Marche, Italy. 11/42
Classic, fresh and elegant stone fruits and floral. Influences from the Adriatic Sea and a unique composition of clay and limestone soils.
- 517 Viognier – “Wild Thing” (92 pts WE)(2021). Carol Shelton. Sonoma - CA 15/ 59
This dry yet super-rich and mouth-filling wine overflows with honeysuckle, peach syrup, poached pears, popcorn and toasted almond flavors on a full body and lush, viscous texture. It's so ripe and extreme, and so good!

RED WINES

- 601 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico (2012)(93 pts WE). Nicolis. Veneto - Italy 129
Corvina 65% – Rondinella 20% – Molinara 5% Croatina 10%. Deep dark ruby red which turns into garnet. Powerful and aristocratic nose made of ripe fruit, jam, sensations of cocoa, walnut, tobacco, and leather. Elegant and powerful wine with a spicy bouquet of distinct flavors; an impressive balance between volume and smoothness, warmth and crispness, austerity, and richness.
- 602 Barbaresco (2013)(90 pts WE). Luigi Voghera. Piedmont - Italy 99
This leads with menthol, new leather, exotic spice and balsamic notes. The concentrated palate offers dried black cherry, tobacco and star anise flavors set against firm, fine-grained tannins and bright acidity.
- 603 Barolo (2013)(DOCG)(91 pts. WE). Réva. Monforte D'Alba. Italy 129
Rose petal, red-skinned berry and leather aromas take center stage. The juicy palate offers Morello cherry, clove and white pepper alongside taut fine-grained tannins.
- 604 Blaufränkisch (2020). Channing Daughters. North Fork – Long Island 18/69
The aromas and flavors are full of black raspberries, blackberries, plums, boysenberries, violets, brown spice and black pepper. This is a dry, supple, sexy wine with Burgundian texture and great concentration. The alcohol is moderate (12%), the acids juicy and balanced, the tannins are present but soft, and the wine offers a great deal of pleasure and a long, delicious finish.
- 605 Bordeaux Red Blend – *Pentimento* (2014). Chateau Beausejour. St. Émilion - France 18/69
75 Merlot/25 Cab Franc. From Michele D'Aprix, the only female American winemaker in Bordeaux! Nose of dark chocolate, espresso, black plums, raspberry, and baking spice. Palate is grippy, woody, black fruit and sweet oak. Dry finish.
- 606 Bordeaux Red (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot). Chateau Pauillac. Pauillac - France 104
Ruby color. Charming nose dominated by violets, round and velvety on the palate with black fruit aromas. Silky and delightful. Delicate on the finish, tannins are ripe and rich. Long finish.
- 607 Brunello di Montalcino (2018)(91 pts WS). Albatreti. Tuscany -Italy 169
Aromas of forest floor, oak-driven spice, crushed aromatic herb and blue flower slowly appear in the glass. On the rounded, full-bodied palate, taut, fine-grained tannins and fresh acidity accompany juicy black cherry, coffee bean and licorice.
- 608 Burgundy – *Vieilles Vignes de Pinot Noir* (2020)(92 pts WE). Albert Bichot. Beaune - France 16/58
Old vines. Flattering nose with an appealing palette of fruity aromas (black currant, red currant, plum). Fleshy and balanced.
- 609 Cabernet Franc “Bordo Antico” (89 pts. WE). Anthony Nappa. North Fork - Long Island 16/59
A gentle spiced cranberry aroma starts off this red, with fresh herbal accents of thyme and savory chiming in. It's driven by tart red berry flavors on the palate, flecked by dried chile and herbs. Light rustic tannins and mild acidity lend support.
- 610 Cabernet Sauvignon – *In Sheep's Clothing* (2020). Maison Noir. Washington 13/52
Delivers a ripeness of fruit flavors while preserving the acidity that gives the medium to full-bodied wine a sense of freshness. With layers of cassia, blueberries, and black cherries, this wine lends to a New World style of fruit with more of an Old World structure with a hint of wood smoke. This wine fully embraces an integral part of classic Cabernet Sauvignon by highlighting a complex blend of dried herbs: anise, thyme and bay leaf.
- 611 Cabernet Sauvignon (Cabernet Franc and Merlot) – *Mercury Head* (2018). Orin Swift. Napa 294
Dark violet with a ruby crown. Aromatics of plum and cherry, dark chocolate, leather and Rutherford Dust coalesce from the glass. The entry is elegant and floods the palate with notes of cassia, blackberry, blueberry, caramel and a touch of cinnamon and brown sugar. Rich and bold. Seamless and focused. Closes with lingering dusty tannins and a touch of baking chocolate.

- 612 Cabernet Sauvignon – *Palermo* (2018)(90 pts RP). Orin Swift. Napa 140
Delicious aromas of raspberry and cherry intermingle with notes of star anise, five spice and freshly steeped black tea. The palate is softly textured and smooth with a combination of cassis and blackberry notes. Lengthy finish.
- 613 Cabernet Sauvignon – *Double Back* (2019)(94 pts). Bledsoe Family. Columbia Valley - Washington 344
Drew Bledsoe's retirement plan, after 14 years as an NFL quarterback, Doubleback brought him back to his hometown of Walla Walla to make wine. Crushed rock aromas open on a savory note, joining complex veins of dark fruit wrapped in tobacco leaf and mint. Vibrant energy and impressive structure; lovely berry fruit balanced with crushed herbs.
- 614 Cabernet Sauvignon - Estate (2020)(92 pts WE). Ghost Block. Oakville – California 189
Organic. 5% Malbec and 5% Petit Verdot; perfumed nose of sage, lavender and rose petal. Persistent tones of clove and baking spice complement a brooding blackberry and sanguine notes. Beautiful, well-rounded mouth feel. Medium bodied, elegant finish.
- 615 Cinsaut (60%), Tempranillo (20%), Syrah (10%), Carignan (10%) – *Amphora* (2020) 23/89
 Château Kefraya. Bekaa Valley - Lebanon
This blend is the first Lebanese wine made in clay jars to be released since the Phoenicians (4,000 years ago). Aromas of violet, black cherry, ripe strawberry, raisins, and forest floor. The palate has a long finish of red and black fruit.
- 616 Côtes-du-Rhône – *Espirit* (2021). Brotte. Rhône Valley - France 11/ 42
This Grenache-Syrah blend will impress with its wild red fruits and spices, plus that authentic dried brush (garrigue) and lavender which is so distinctive to this region. Easy drinking, food-friendly, crowd-pleasing.
- 617 Grenache Cuvée (Syrah, Mourvedre) – *Cherries & Rainbows* (2020). Languedoc - France 13/49
Sulfite-free. Organic. Plum, dark cherry, boysenberry, blackberry, violet, sage, forest floor, menthol, eucalyptus and black licorice.
- 618 Grenache Cuvée (Syrah, Petite Sirah) - *Abstract* (2016)(92 pts WS). Orin Swift. Napa 22/84
Aromatic notes of Luxardo cherries, ripe black plums and raspberries billow, with intricate hints of coffee, mocha and caramel. The entry is expansive with dark briar fruits, cola and cocoa with soft tannins. Finishes with a sweet oak presence.
- 619 Malbec - *Finca Pirca* (2012)(88 pts.WS). Familia Mayol. Mendoza – Argentina 96
High Altitude Malbec (3,478 feet above from Uco Valley). Aromas of blackberry, violets and a hint of graphite. Fresh fruit and smoky notes on the midpalate give way to a balanced finish.
- 620 Merlot – *The Scooter* (2019)(90 pts WS). Mollydooker. Australia 18/69
An aromatic lift of plum, spice and chocolate with a seamless structure; 65-75% fruit weight.
- 621 Petite Sirah, Syrah, Grenache – *Machete* (2016)(92 pts. WS). Orin Swift. Napa, CA 128
A nose of black plums, cassis, and cacao engage. A progressing palate of blackberry and boysenberry compote, a reduction of dark plum and ripe figs and pure Amarena cherry. Flashes of vanilla and traces of minerality evolve into chalky tannins on the finish.
- 622 Pinot Noir (2020)(92 pts. WE). Anton Bauer. Wagram - Austria 17/68
Precise balance between the fruit and acidity that makes it fresh and lively. A typical Pinot Noir nose with strawberries, raspberries and floral notes such as violets. The palate is well balanced, elegant, and it has a long finish tasting of red berries.
- 623 Pinot Noir – *Slander* (2019)(91 pts. Wine Advocate). Orin Swift. Napa 112
Pale to medium ruby-purple color, this wine springs from the glass with notes of raspberry tart, cranberry sauce and rhubarb pie plus hints of Provence herbs and forest floor. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is softly spoken with a nice chewiness.
- 624 Pinot Noir – *Ten* (2020)(94 pts. WE). Sea Smoke. Central Coast - California 195
Biodynamic. A brooding and intense wine. The aromas begin with notes of Elderberry, Freesia and Fig, then a myriad of savory spices, and a hint of lavender. Firm, mature tannins are followed by a long, velvety finish.

- 625 Rioja (Tempranillo) – *Izarbe. Reserve.* (2017)(94 pts. WE). Familia Chavarri. Spain 21/79
Heady, rich, balsamic aromas fold in notes of cedar, tobacco, and black cherry in front of a fully ripe, superbly balanced palate. Mocha, espresso, fudge, e3 blackberry flavors finish with spicy, mossy, dry notes and a final wave of blackened toast and tannins.
- 626 Sangiovese (2016)(87 pts. WE). Noelia Ricci. Romagna - Italy 17/65
Aromas of red berry and underbrush. Cheerful palate of strawberry, cinnamon and a hint of orange peel alongside smooth tannins.
- 627 Sangiovese Blend – “Keith Haring Red”(2015)(87 pts. WE). Tenuta di Ceppaiano. Tuscany 18/69
As a friend of the vineyard owner, artist Keith Haring designed this label prior to his death. A blend of 60% Sangiovese, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 10% Merlot, this wine has aromas of earth, black-skinned fruit, and leather. Rounded palate of plum and vanilla alongside soft, relaxed tannins.
- 628 Shiraz - *Blue-Eyed Boy* (2015)(92 pts WS). Mollydooker. Australia 114
Smooth, rich, and satiny; incredibly aromatic with alluring notes of blackberry, cherry, licorice, and vanilla bean.
- 629 Shiraz - *Carnival of Love* (2016)(93 pts WS). Mollydooker. Australia 215
At 85-95% fruit weight, it has elegance; an intense and seamless flavor spectrum; sumptuous mouth-feel and perfect balance. Voted “Top Wine in the World” three years in a row by Wine Enthusiast.
- 630 St. Laurent (94 pts WE)(2017). Steindorfer. Austria 20/77
Intense dark berry bouquet, well-balanced palate with rich fruit, elegant and substantial. Very memorable.
- 631 Syrah (2017). Channing Daughters. North Fork - Long Island 21/79
Blue-fruited, blackberry, bacon and lilac-driven wine with a great savory quality and wonderful length. Bright, juicy acidity ad moderate alcohol. Pairs well with roast chicken, steaks and chops, mushrooms, and grains.
- 632 Syrah Cuvée – *Para Maria* (2021)(91 pts. WE). Stolpman. Los Olivos - CA 13/50
This blend of Syrah (80%), Petite Verdot (20%) delivers a core of red and black fruit with notes of black pepper, anise, and hints of red cherry. A dark and brooding wine.
- 633 Tannat (2018)(92 pts. WE). Bodega Garzón. Uruguay 11/39
A ripe version of Tannat, with earth and blackberry aromas leading the charge. Toasty dark-fruit flavors benefit from integrated oak, adding some pepper to the finish. The palate has a lot of grip, making this best with red meat.
- 634 Touriga Nacional Cuvée – *Dezoito by Maniche* (2019). Quinta da Pacheca. Dão - Portugal 19/74
Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca and Tinta Roriz present an intense and young ruby color. Very fruity in the aroma, with evident blackberry and plum aromas, balanced with chocolate notes provided by the barrels, shows balance in the mouth, with solid tannins and a long and persistent finish.
- 635 Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore (2020)(88 pts WE). Taveggia. Verona - Italy 18/69
Cherries, dried fruit and hints of black spice, dried cardamon and viola. Fresh with tight nit, polished tannins
- 636 Zinfandel Cuvée - *The Prisoner* (2019) (92 pts WE). The Prisoner Wine Co. Napa Valley 20/95
Inspired by the wines first made by the first Italian immigrants in Napa Valley, The Prisoner has led the resurgence of interesting blends by incorporating Zinfandel with the unlikely mix of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, Syrah, and Charbono. Bright aromas of raspberry, vanilla, and coconut give way to flavors of blackberry, pomegranate, and vanilla; lingering and luscious finish.
- 637 Zweigelt (cuvée) – *Ried Bärnreiser Anna Christina* (2016)(94 pts WE). Netzl 165
Zweigelt blended with Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Dark plum, chocolate and graphite on the nose still need to unfurl fully. The dense palate, filled to the brim with these flavors, is tightly wound and bound in its firm but fine structure of drying, taut tannins. This is elegant, sinuous, and serious — in intent, and in the pleasure it offers. Organic.
